

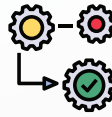

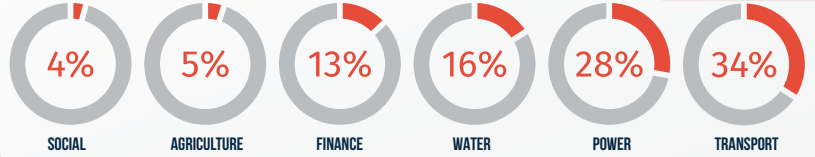

Light up & power Africa

- **900 km** of power lines constructed
- Nearly **1,152 MW** added to the national grid
- Approximately **6.2 million** households have been connected to the national grid
- Reduced the average kWh cost from **USD 0.16 (2013) to USD 0.19 (2016)**



Improve the quality of life for the people of Africa

- Over **51,000 jobs** created
- Improved water supply for over **500,000 people**
- Increased the access to sanitation services, significantly decreasing the **BOD5** (biochemical oxygen demand) in the effluent



Feed Africa

- Increase in agricultural productivity in areas with Bank supported operations by **53-237%** for selected crops
- About **4,890 ha** of land brought under irrigation
- Improved net returns to farmers from **USD 165 to USD 1,110** per household per year
- **11,750 ha** of degraded forest area recovered and **271,081 ha** protected



Industrialize Africa

- **6,000 youth** have been trained on middle level skills and entrepreneurship
- Provided support to engineering faculties in terms of provision of equipment, training of staff and strengthening of curriculum and research
- Rehabilitation of road networks, which connect major manufacturing sites to vital urban centers



Integrate Africa

- Establishment of a Center of Excellence in Urology and Nephrology Science
- Rehabilitation/construction of road network to improve regional connectivity, reduce transport cost and travel time and reduce trade flows
- Development of power networks
